

Palouse Cares - 2019 Donation Request Form

About Palouse Cares

Palouse Cares is a local non-profit organization committed to raising funds, food and awareness that benefit individuals and families in need on the Palouse. We believe that no one should go hungry. Each year, Palouse Cares hosts a food drive and auction and distributes the proceeds and food raised to local organizations.

Eligibility:

In order to receive funds from Palouse Cares, please complete and submit the following Grant Request Form. To be eligible for funding, an applicant must be a public charity with tax-exempt status under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Applicants shall not discriminate based on sex, race, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, religion, age, color, creed, national or ethnic origin, marital status, status as a veteran, physical, mental or sensory disability, and/or genetic information.

What we are looking for:

In order to be considered for funds, applicants must demonstrate they provide support or programs for families or individuals, or are addressing food insecurity on the Palouse. Strong applicants will demonstrate partnerships and collaborations with other organizations.

Important Dates and Requirements: Donation applications are due no later than Wednesday, May 15, 2019. **Interviews and presentations are scheduled for May 23, 2019.** Auction and Food Drive will be December 7, 2019. Funds will be disbursed in January.

Process: All grant applications will be reviewed by the Palouse Cares Board of Directors. Select applicants will be required to give a short presentation and interview for final selection. Successful applicants will be notified no later than August 1, 2019.

Available funds are dependent upon the amount raised during the annual fundraising event on December 7, 2019. In 2018, Palouse Cares distributed 35,000 pounds of food and \$45,000 to organizations in 13 local communities. Palouse Cares is volunteer-driven, which means 100% of the proceeds goes back into the local community. We have no paid staff.
